<u>**Seniors who have multiple science classes should check with the teacher or the high</u> <u>school office to confirm date and time for their exams.</u>

Students should be in the assigned room at least 10 minutes prior to testing. (Testing rooms will be announced the week of exams.)

Exams will begin promptly at the scheduled time. Students will not be permitted to enter the classroom once testing has started. If tardy, they will report to the high school office to sign in and then go to the library. Students will need to make up any exams missed due to tardiness or illness on Friday, December 8. <u>Please ensure that your student arrives on time during the exam days.</u>

<u>Seniors do not exempt exams in December</u>; that privilege applies only to the spring exams for seniors who meet both grade and attendance requirements (High School Student/Parent Handbook, section 5.13).

Seniors will be on a <u>half-day schedule</u> for these exam days; all students must leave school grounds promptly at the end of the second examination period (11:15). Students who do not have an exam during the second session will leave campus at 9:15 or sit in the library for a silent study hall. Students who do not have an exam during the first testing session will not need to report to the campus until 9:30.

<u>Dress code</u>: The students are to be in GCHS dress code. Students who report for an exam and who do not meet dress code requirements will be sent to the office.
