At GCS, your child will:

Exploring their natural curiosity

Each child learns at their own pace, and knowing when your child is ready to start kindergarten can be a challenging decision. How will they perform academically? Will they thrive socially? And what type of learning environment will best meet their needs?

We designed our program to give students the space they need to explore and create. The full-day and half-day options keep kindergartners challenged while setting the right pace, whether they have gone to pre-K or are entering school for the first time.

Our kindergartners flourish through:

Care and support.

Our teachers give the right amount of attention to students and ensure each child feels seen and their concerns heard in our small class sizes.

Active learning approach.

We provide a hands-on approach, giving students the chance to use all their senses to discover, learn, and create. Our curriculum focuses on intensive phonics for reading mastery, writing, math, and a variety of enrichments through music, art, library, STEAM, and computer. Students also explore social studies, science, and critical thinking with the Think & Learn curriculum.

Stimulating environment.

Students develop fine and gross motor skills through our gym and playground spaces. In our learning centers for music, computer, and arts, young ones explore their hobbies and passions.

Biblical worldview.

Children learn about the Bible and Christian values during chapel and in class. They are inspired to live out their faith through their words and actions by teachers who model positive character traits, like kindness and humility

Elementary (Grades 1-5)

Building a strong foundation for lifelong learners

Elementary students are engaged in hands-on exploration in a socially and emotionally supportive space. It's a time when deep and lasting friendships are formed, and students are challenged in an atmosphere that is collaborative and nurturing. Our small class sizes allow for differentiated instruction, which honors children as individuals who learn and develop at their own pace.



Academic Development:

Students will find a fun and challenging curriculum that includes Bible, language arts, math, science, social studies, and handwriting. Lessons are taught in ways that encourage mastery, all while keeping children engaged.



Biblical Worldview:

Using a Christ-centric approach to learning, children pursue academic excellence through a strong curriculum while also growing their faith. Our teachers model our core values of honoring God and showing compassion to others. Through attending chapel and Bible lessons, elementary students have a deeper understanding of what it is like to be a disciple of Christ.



Enriched Learning:

Our students explore unique interests in special weekly classes in art, music, STEAM, library, and physical education. These enrichments provide an avenue for children to hone their creativity and to build their character through teamwork.

Cultivating emerging gifts and academic interests

Middle school is when our students really start to come into their own. They're busy discovering new passions and talents while also starting to better understand who they are and what they stand for. We prepare them for what's ahead by challenging them with a more rigorous curriculum and encouraging them to be more involved in our learning community.

At Gaston Christian School, we introduce middle schoolers to what's possible and instill in them the confidence and character they need to achieve it. Your child will:

- Master core subjects and explore courses that interest them personally and professionally, including three years of personal finance for all students
- Benefit from an engaging, age-appropriate curriculum, with a cellphone-free policy and educators who love teaching middle school
- Take part in our House System, exclusive to middle school, allowing students to serve as mentors to lower grade levels and emphasizing collaboration through service projects
- Build healthy relationships with peers through involvement in clubs, student organizations, and team sports
 - *East Cleveland campus offers 6th-7th grade with plans to add 8th grade

- Develop skills in fine arts, with options in band, chorus, theatre, praise team, and woodworking
- Strengthen important life skills needed for success in high school, college, and careers, including selfdiscipline, initiative, empathy, and discipleship

Our main campus sits on 66 acres and has been serving local Christian families since 1980.


